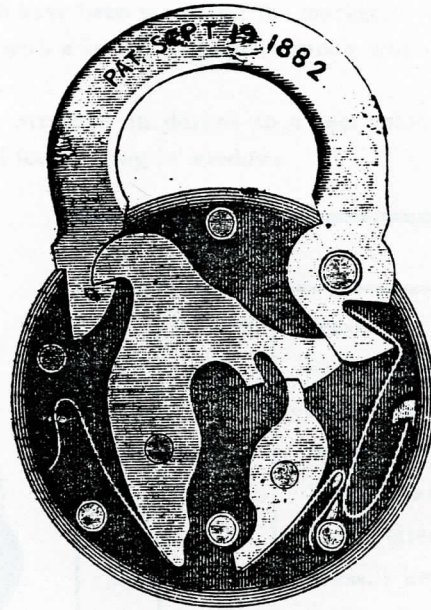

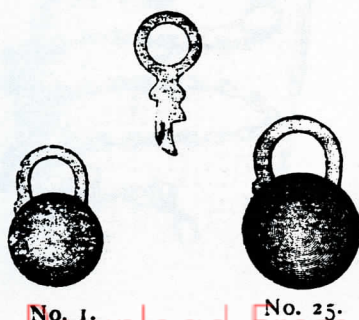

PERFECTION KEY HOLDERS.

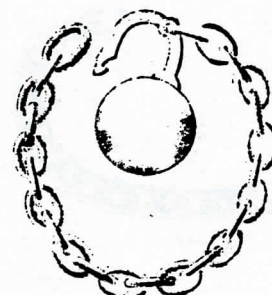
These Key Holders are composed of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch Padlocks, with a suitable chain for carrying keys.

They are handsomely nickel plated, are an entire novelty, and need only to be tried to prove their superiority over anything yet devised for the purpose.

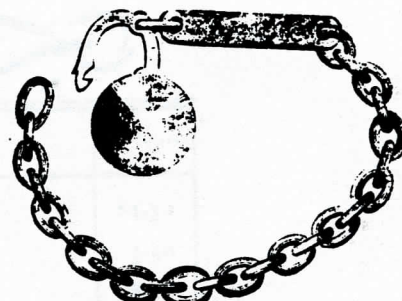
They are attached in dozens to a lithographic card, arranged for hanging in windows.
